

## Continuing Care Retirement Communities (CCRCs)

Continuing Care Retirement Communities (CCRCs) are a long-term care option that combines [independent living](#), [assisted living](#), and skilled nursing in one setting. The goal of CCRCs is to provide long-term services and supports that meet your changing needs over time without requiring that you move outside the community. Your place in the next level of care is there for you and your future care needs are already planned for from the moment you move in allowing you to safely age in place.

A CCRC is the most expensive long-term care option. It requires a large up-front entrance fee as well as monthly charges. The entrance fee is essentially an investment in your future care. You are buying into a property and a system of care that, in turn, commits to meet your future care needs.

## What is Assisted Living?

An [assisted living facility](#) is a residential senior care option that provides non-medical assistance with activities of daily living. This includes personal care services like bathing, dressing, and grooming. It also includes medication management, meals, housekeeping, transportation and supervision.
